- 1. Create an inspiring vision for the COE and how this new facility would fit/enable the vision
- 2. Need an architectural plan of the facility or a model.
 - a. Need something to enable people to see the vision
 - b. Need to work up a "2-pager" on why this is important to the college/quality of education
- 3. Need statistics to back up the need for the facility.
 - a. It has to be more than a want- make it a need.
 - b. What will it do?
 - c. How do you know?
- 4. Need a top to bottom plan, not just a glossy. Story needs to be told what this money is needed for
- 5. Tough to fund "bricks and mortar" projects; people like WOW features and to have their name prominently displayed. What is the WOW of this project?

The Project Needs a University Leader

- 1. Most universities have a VP to raise funds. Is NMSU behind this?
- 2. Should be led by a University employee; Council would work with that person
- 3. Dean's Council has by-laws, but no legal standing
 - a. We can queue up people, but only an official university representative can ask for money <u>is this true or not?</u>
- 4. Estimates are that this is a 2-3 year job

Brainstorming Ideas

- 1. Foundations know how to change a future cash flow to cash today
- 2. Get a list of top donors who graduated from mechanical and chemical engineering. (This sum of money is too large to achieve it with small donors only.)
 - a. Get their input or document
 - b. Make them feel part of the effort
 - c. Get their buy-in
- 3. Find a few to donate half of the goal; Offer naming opportunities
