Glenn Allen Frost, 79, passed away Saturday, Jan. 10, 2015 at the Mission Arch Care Center in Roswell.

Glenn was born on March 5, 1935 in El Paso, Texas to Orvel "Bobo" and Ina "Ma" (Scoggins) Frost. He was then raised in Anthony, New Mexico.
